RULES & REGULATIONS

- ♦ Students are required to wear proper uniform and display their Student ID Cards at all times.
- ♦ All students should reach the School in time.
- ♦ School will remain closed on 1st and 3rd Saturday of every month.
- ♦ Appropriate language must be used at all times & Complete abstinence from violence.
- ♦ Use of motorised vehicles in the School premises is strictly not allowed.
- → Bullying or ragging is completely prohibited.
- → High standards of discipline to be followed in the School premises at all times.
- → The School reserves the right to suspend, rusticate or expel any student not following the code of conduct laid down by the School.
- → Parents/Guardians are not expected to visit their child/ward in classrooms anytime during the school operating hours, unless they are invited by the School.
- → All belongings of the students should be carried by the child. No delivery of items is permitted in the School.
- ♦ No student will be allowed to leave the School early, except in case of emergency or in case the student is unwell. Such leave shall be granted on the discretion of School Principal's approval.
- ♦ Kindly ensure that your child does not carry any valuable item to the School.
- ♦ No mobile phone is allowed to be carried to the school by any student without explicit and written permission of the Principal/Head of the School.
- → Parents should ensure that the child is dedicating time towards his or her home-work and gets complete set of books as per the prescribed time-table and booklist.
- ♦ Private tuitions are strictly discouraged.
- ♦ Students are expected to respect the property of others and of the School.
- ◆ Any knives, crackers, water-pistols, explosives or any other lethal object which may cause threat or injury or damage to School property are strictly prohibited to carry to the School premises.
- ◆ School fee must be paid within 10th of every month in advance.
- Fee will be charged for all 12 calendar months. Kindly refer to the Fee Policy for the exact amount to be paid.
- ♦ No student will be allowed to appear for the examination unless all dues are cleared.
- ◆ Incomplete payment of fee will be treated as non-payment of fee and will be subject to a late-fee penalty.
- → If there is a regular delay in fee payment, student's name will be struck off the rolls. Parents/Guardians will then have to apply for re-admission.
